1. Treasurer's Report

Cindy Durr reported fund balances as follows:

2. 2008 Shirt Sales and Other Fund-raising

2008 Shirts

Tina Zachery shared the design workups received from Sarah Moore for next year's All-Sport shirts. Discussion took place to ensure all sports were represented. Suggestions were made in reference to the wrestling art work. Tina will ask Sarah if any better representation of wrestling would be available.

Garry Jessup made a motion to approve the 2008 shirt design and the motion was seconded by Cecilia Dietz. The 2008 shirt design was approved with a unanimous vote.

Shirts are gray with baseball style black sleeves. Our cost of the shirts will be approximately \$9.50. Shirts will be sold for \$15.00. Our goal is to start selling them at the July 4th booth.

Culver's Fundraising

Tina Reported that beginning in May, the 3rd Wednesday of each month Culver's in Noblesville will donate 10% of their in-dining room profits earned between 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. to the Booster Club. We will publicize through our website, bank signs, school announcements (Lea Jessup will take care of those avenues), and Sheridan's "Our Hometown" web newsletter (Garry Jessup will coordinate).

Tina will contact Culver's to verify whether or not they need any Sheridan personnel to help with these events.

Mike's Carwash

Tina was going to contact Mike's Carwash regarding their fund-raising opportunities, however the volleyball team is doing a Mike's Carwash fundraiser, so we will not be pursuing this fund-raiser.

Scholastic Sports

We were contacted by Scholastic Sports regarding their fund-raising opportunities, however this is more based on students selling products to raise money, and we are not looking for students to do any selling.

Hoosier Authority

Kim and Tina have purchased shirts that they brought to show the group. They noted that they were happy with the quality and felt it was a good value for the price, however please note that shipping was not as timely as previously promised. It took a week and a half as opposed to the two day turn-around time frame. Shipping is free.

YTB –Your Travel Biz

Suzie and Darrell Nichols were in attendance and presented a funding opportunity for the Booster Club to consider. They promote a travel website service, similar to Expedia and Travelocity, that would have an association to Sheridan, such as www.sheridanblackhawktravel.com. The Booster Club would receive a portion of the profits from people who book vacations or travel services through this site. The site is maintained by an outside company and could generate a potential earnings of \$4,000 - \$7,000 per year. Normally there would be an upfront charge of \$500 to get this set up, however the Nichols' stated they would donate that to the Booster Club. There would be a \$10.00 annual maintenance fee each year. The Booster Club thanked the Nichols for their offer and will take it under consideration. This would have to be a combined association with the school, and would likely require more investigation and school attorney involvement if we decide to pursue.

50/50

Kim and Mike will be getting together in May to finalize the paperwork for an exempt status for the 50/50 drawings.

3. Scholarship Committee Report

Packets were coordinated through the High School Guidance Counselors. Applications were very well filled out. Two student athletes (one boy and one girl) were selected for scholarships and will be announced at the Senior Awards Night in May.
