**1. Treasurer's Report**

Fund balances were reported as follows:

**General Fund** - \$4,547.94

With outstanding expenses expected of \$1,500.00

**Ring Fund** - \$100.37

**2. Stadium Flag Update**

Kim Zachery reported that the price of Stadium flags for the top of the football stadium would be:

If you purchase a quantity of 8-12 they would be \$110 each

If you purchase a quantity of 12 or more they are \$72 each

It was decided to table this purchase at this time.

**3. Coach\Athletic Dept. Request**

Cheri Hume attended representing the SHS Athletic Department. They have taken ownership of the varsity event programs and are completely redesigning them and will produce a more professional program for all varsity home events.

They have sold approximately \$4,000.00 in advertisements from local merchants. They were looking at outsourcing the production of these programs, which was estimated at \$5,000 for a limited supply.

They are investigating the potential purchase of an industrial type printer that would produce professional copies with features such as folding, stapling, color printing, and the ability to print on thicker card stock.

This would give them the flexibility to print what they need when they need it instead of paying such a significant amount to have a limited supply printed.

The estimate they have for such a printer is \$10,000. They are asking the Booster Club to consider contributing to this purchase and becoming a sponsor so to speak of the program.

Several of the other schools that we researched have this same arrangement where the programs are funded by the Booster Clubs either all or in part.

Cheri had a sample of the cover to show.

Funding sources for this purchase would be coming from a combination of the advertisements sold, the School Corporation, and the Booster Club.

Cindy Durr made a motion to pledge \$1,500 initially for this purchase and another \$1,500 when our general fund balance reaches \$5,000. The motion was seconded by Garry Jessup and unanimously approved.

**4. Other Business**

Brenda Garrod from Mama's Cupboard expressed a need for old Sheridan shirts. She asked that anyone who had Sheridan apparel that they have outgrown, no longer have a need for, etc. she would be happy to have and distribute.
