The Sheridan Adult Booster Club regular meeting was held on December 21, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. in the Sheridan Middle School Media Center. Mrs. Summe called the meeting to order.

1. Treasurer's Report (Carol Miller)

Fund balances were reported as following:

\$100.37 in Ring Fund with \$5,960.94 in General Fund, less funds encumbered leaving a balance of \$5,155.94.

2. Fund-raising Update (Joni Summe)

Joni Summe reported that she took the 2008 inventory to Sheridan Elementary School, Sheridan Middle School, and MAMAs Cupboard. We currently have samples of the 2009-10 apparel. From this point forward, apparel purchase is on an order only basis.

Carol Miller suggested that we offer sweatshirts with differently embroidery options for a set fee.

Bob VanVoorst thought another pork loin sale at a basketball game would be a good fund-raiser. Mrs. Summe will contact the athletic director to inquire about this possibility. There was further discussion of having a booth at the Harvest Moon Festival in October, having a yard sale, seeking other corporate sponsorships, and also increasing membership dues in July to \$25, \$50, \$75, and \$100. Finally, the club will ask the announcer at the boys' basketball games to make announcements about visiting the booth and joining the club.

Mrs. Summe also noted that Mr. Williamson would like to start a 5K run in conjunction with the Club in order to fund the weight room renovations.

3. Winter Membership Drive

Joni Summe reported on the status of membership as follows:

69 members: 20-Championships, 19-Red, 18-Black, and 11 White

4. Coaches' Requests
