Meeting Minutes

The May meeting minutes were presented and no changes to those minutes were requested.

1. By Laws
  - a. Discussion took place on whether or not we needed By Laws. It was decided that we do not need them at this time, but can put together guidelines as we go along.
  
2. Flip-flop Sales
  - a. Mike will order flip-flops in sizes youth – adult customized with the Blackhawk logo and “S” in order for us to sell as a fundraiser at the July 4<sup>th</sup> festival. Kim will secure a booth for the cost of \$15.00. Items can also be sold at fall sporting events.
  - b. July 4<sup>th</sup> SABC booth will also be selling the remaining T-shirts and hats that we have. SABC memberships will also be available at the booth in various increments. Mike Shelburne also donated 4 pairs (8 total) of athletic passes to raffle. Passes are good for adult admission to all home varsity sporting events. It was decided that a \$25.00 membership would give a person one entry in the drawing; \$50.00 – two entries; \$100.00 – 4 entries in the drawing.

3. Blackout Night
  - a. During the previous meeting we discussed holding a “Blackout” night where we would sell black shirts and designate particular games to wear the shirts, trying to encourage the crowd to create a “Blackout”. It was discussed that it might be a good idea to create a generic shirt with a logo such as Blackhawk Athletics instead of focusing in on one sport so that each team can have “Blackout” nights and fans don’t have to buy a shirt for multiple sports.
  - b. Sheila Evans will investigate shirt design and costs.
  - c. Football “Blackout” night would be the first home game.
  
4. Website
  - a. Garry Jessup will purchase a domain name and begin the design of the SABC website. Items to include are Mission statement (who we are and what we do), Membership information and downloadable application form, Meeting dates\times, Meeting minutes, Fund Raising information and current promotions, Upcoming events. Garry will email everyone as the site progresses to obtain feedback and suggestions.
  
5. Membership Forms On-line
  - a. Kim will email Lea with the membership form in order to put on-line when the website is developed. It was suggested that the form be modified from its current wording that makes it appear most if not all of the membership fees goes towards scholarships. The wording will be something to the effect of: “Your membership goes toward the support of all of the Blackhawk athletic teams for items such as uniforms, equipment, potential scholarships and special athletic needs.
  
6. Fund-raising Committee
  - a. Sheila Evans agreed to head the fund-raising committee
  - b. Kim Zachery will create fliers for fund-raising info and see if we can get kids to pass them out at the July 4<sup>th</sup> parade.
  - c. Kim also shared fund-raising ideas that Westfield has done, including: Sale of Mike’s carwash books’ dinner at Chipoltes; football posters; carwash; silent auction, dinner and pep rally, and golf outing.
  - d. Mike Shelburne will contact Melanie Maynard to see if they are planning to sponsor the Bears merchandise raffle as they did last year.
  - e. Kim asked if tailgating, such as the sophomore parents did last year at home football games negatively impacted profits for other organizations such as the grill and concession stand. Mike stated he did not see a problem with that and people were welcome to tailgate.
  - f. Kenny Cline has offered his services if we are interested in pork cookouts such as the one last year during basketball that helped fund the state championship rings.
  - g. SABC booth and items can be set up at all home varsity events. Just need workers to man it.

## 7. Scholarship Committee

- a. Kim reviewed the process they went through at the May meeting in order to select SABC scholarship winners. Four \$500.00 scholarships were awarded on May 30, 2007 during Senior Awards Night.
- b. Mike Shelburne shared his original experience with the Booster organization, which focused more on helping with the sporting teams as opposed to scholarships only touching a few students. For example, he stated that with the \$2,000.00 that was awarded to only four students, that same amount of money could buy uniforms for an entire team and positively affect 18 students as opposed to four.
- c. It was agreed that in the 2007-2008 school year, the SABC would award two \$500.00 scholarships.
- d. Discussion took place on the criteria of scholarship awards. It seems to be somewhat vague and confusing. It was suggested that we look at re-vamping the scholarship selection process, including an application submission form that the athletes must fill out. Cindy Durr and Cheri Hume agreed to be on the scholarship committee and come back with some recommendations.

## 8. Membership Levels

- a. Previous years, membership to the SABC was \$10.00. There seems to be some confusion as to whether this was a single membership or for a family membership. It was suggested we create the following levels of membership so that people could decide what level best fits their needs:
  - i. White - \$10.00
  - ii. Black - \$25.00
  - iii. Red - \$50.00
  - iv. Championship - \$100.00
- b. Membership will be available via on-line forms, at the July 4<sup>th</sup> booth, and during sporting events. Garry Jessup will make a SABC vinyl banner for our booth/table.

## 9. Wish List for coaches

- a. It was suggested that instead of the SABC sending a request to each of the varsity coaches, that it come from Mr. Shelburne so that he could coordinate their needs with us. This way we wouldn't duplicate anything Mike might have planned to purchase. He will send out a letter to all varsity coaches.

#### 10. Football Schedule

- a. The Tipton game on September 28<sup>th</sup> will be played at the RCA dome this year instead of at Tipton. Ticket cost will be \$10.00.
- b. The pre-season scrimmage will be at home. Good time to have our booth to sell items and memberships.
